

CWP Update 2009 Plenary Meeting: September 18 - 19, 2008

The California Water Plan is hosting its second Plenary session on September 18 – 19, 2008 at the DoubleTree Hotel in Sacramento. The Plenary will bring together all participants of Update 2009 – the Advisory Committee, Steering Committee, regional stakeholders, the Statewide Water Analysis Network, and members of the general public. The agenda will build on the work of the recent regional workshops and All-Region Forum.

The two-day meeting will feature a preview of the Pre-Administrative Draft of Update 2009, including: State Companion Planning and key themes for California Water Today; and Staff Draft Recommendations.
