- To be released in the interim years between Water Plan Updates (12/12).

# Our plan

- Chapter 7 of Volume 1 is the Implementation Plan for the 2009 Water Plan Update.
- 13 Objectives: 115+ related actions
  - By State and local agencies
  - Derived from public input, companion plans, recent legislation
  - Varying timelines and specificity

Ask Caucuses to report on progress of relevant Objectives and actions.

# What happened

- We took the evaluation forms to several caucuses.
- The caucuses had concerns, didn't feel they could in good faith fill out the evaluations.
  - Needed more definition/representation/data
  - Couldn't speak for whole State
- (The Tribal Advisory Committee did fill one out.)
- We asked agency staff to fill out evaluations for each objective.
- We've gotten seven back; will be showing you today.

- 3. Expand Conjunctive Management of Multiple Supplies**
- 4. Protect Surface Water and Groundwater Quality**
- 5. Expand Environmental Stewardship**
- 6. Practice Integrated Flood Management**
- 7. Manage a Sustainable California Delta**
- 8. Prepare Prevention, Response, and Recovery Plans**
- 9. Reduce Energy Consumption of Water Systems and Uses**
- 10. Improve Data and Analysis for Decision-making**
- 11. Invest in New Water Technology**
- 12. Improve Tribal Water and Natural Resources**
- 13. Ensure Equitable Distribution of Benefits**
