

FloodSAFE Program Stakeholder Briefings

The Department of Water Resources (DWR) is pleased to announce a series of FloodSAFE Program stakeholder briefings beginning in June 2008. (See inset for dates and locations.)

During these briefings, DWR will:

- introduce the draft FloodSAFE Strategic Plan and invite public comment;
- describe recent FloodSAFE Program accomplishments and upcoming activities; and
- provide information about the Federal Flood Control Subventions Program and current status of the regulations development process.

At briefings held within the Central Valley, DWR will also:

- provide information about activities underway to improve Central Valley flood protection, including initiation of a stakeholder process to develop the newly required Central Valley Flood Protection Plan; and
- discuss AB 156 reporting requirements for local levee maintaining agencies.

Content and discussion during the briefing sessions are organized and scheduled as distinct modules with firm start times. Stakeholders are invited to attend any portion or the entire briefing session according to their interests. (Agenda for the Sacramento-area briefing is enclosed.)
