**The second DWR Mountain Counties Regional Forum on Water Management and Planning is scheduled for Thursday, June 20, 2013 from 1:00 – 4:30 p.m.** The primary meeting location will be in Folsom, with a satellite location in North Fork. ### **Why Participate?**

The Forum agenda will focus on finalizing the text for the Mountain Counties Regional Report, which will be published as part of Update 2013 for the California Water Plan. Discussions will focus on the areas of An Executive Summary of the Regional Report will be included in the Water Plan Highlights document - capturing key elements of strategic water planning issues, priorities and recommendations that help inform **statewide investments.**

The meeting will also feature an update on the Policy Principles on Improved Management of California's Headwaters, which were recently adopted by the Board of Directors for the Association of California Water Agencies. Other agenda items include recent developments for related the DWR programs: the release of Flood Future Report recommendations and highlights; and IRWM Strategic Plan workshops.

Representatives of water agencies and collaboratives; local, state, Tribal and federal government; watershed and community groups; conservancies; and the public are welcome and needed for successful dialog.
