The Commission is developing the WSIP to distribute funding from Proposition 1 funds for the public benefits of eligible water storage projects. These briefings are open to all interested parties; however, the intended audience of this document is the technical staff that will be responsible for running models and conducting the technical and economic analysis on proposed projects for the WSIP funding application.
