You are doing a great job facilitating the UAG. I have a few additional thoughts as the info presented earlier this week has saturated my brain.

I think the regional option should be discussed further. I spoke to Erik about why and how I thought it could work and he seems to hear and understand the justification. I look forward to further discussion.

As for the WSCP item, the state came up with a great list of 10 (actually 11) items that should be included in WSCP's. This is a reasonable request and each water supplier should be held to developing those items for their plan BUT each item should be locally specific. Many of our retailers feel 6 stages is too many. I suggest that the state provide guidance on the minimum # of stages, but let the local supplier decide on the details of the stages; the state can require triggers for each stage, but let the local supplier decide on the details of the trigger; the state can require a response actions at each stage, but again let the local supplier decide on the details of the response. If a local supplier doesn't implement a plan, then the state can have a model WSCP that goes into effect.

I look forward to seeing the next iteration.
