However, those have been revised to eliminate all turf in front yards and incorporate a reduced water usage design to meet the water allocation from EMWD., All projects that have received finals during the reporting period included landscape plan checks/approvals completed prior to the MWELo. However, the plans/approvals have been revised to eliminate all turf in residential front yards and incorporate a reduced water usage design to meet the water allocation from EMWD. Commercial/Industrial cannot include turf in their design and have incorporated drought tolerant designs using plants, rocks and ground covers.

Modifications were made to the approved plans/installation to meet the MWELo standards. All plans/installation require water release from EMWD and shall meet the water allocations for the site as determined by EMWD.
9a	<b>Describe actions taken to verify compliance:</b>	Final inspections completed to insure landscaping is installed. Once installed, water consumption is monitored by EMWD.

9c	<b>If so, by what entity?</b>	City of Moreno Valley. (EMWD supplies water).
10	<b>Describe implementation and enforcement measures:</b>	The City reviews and approves a landscape plan with a final inspection. EMWD provides the water (recyclable where available) according to the water budget for that parcel/project. Water release by EMWD.
11	<b>Explain challenges to implementing and enforcing the ordinance:</b>	The City is dependent upon EMWD for enforcement of water usage.

All new landscape reviews include rocks, ground covers, mulch, drought tolerant plants, encouraging desert designs.
