453 (c) All new surface water delivery systems installed within the Contractor's
454 Service Area after the effective date of this Contract shall also comply with the measurement
455 provisions described in subdivision (a) of this Article.

456 (d) The Contractor shall inform the Contracting Officer and the State of
457 California in writing by April 30 of each Year of the monthly volume of surface water delivered
458 within the Contractor's Service Area during the previous Year.

459 (e) The Contractor shall inform the Contracting Officer and the Operating
460 Non-Federal Entity on or before the 20th calendar day of each month of the quantity of Irrigation
461 Water and M&I Water taken during the preceding month.

462 RATES AND METHOD OF PAYMENT FOR WATER

463 7. (a) The Contractor shall pay the United States as provided in this Article for all
464 Delivered Water at Rates, Charges, and the Tiered Pricing Component established in accordance
465 with: (i) the Secretary's ratesetting policy for Irrigation Water adopted in 1988 and the Secretary's
466 then-existing ratesetting policy for M&I Water, which ratesetting policies shall be amended,
467 modified, or superceded only through a public notice and comment procedure; (ii) applicable
468 Federal Reclamation law and associated rules and regulations, or policies; and (iii) other applicable
469 provisions of this Contract. Payments shall be made by cash transaction, electronic funds transfer,
470 or any other mechanism as may be agreed to in writing by the Contractor and the Contracting
471 Officer. The Rates, Charges, and Tiered Pricing Component applicable to the Contractor upon
472 execution of this Contract are set forth in Exhibit "B," as may be revised annually.

473 (b) The Contracting Officer shall notify the Contractor of the Rates, Charges, and
474 Tiered Pricing Component as follows:
