Below are some specific recommendations for additions to the SBX 77 issue paper

1. The issue paper should ask how agencies will account for water supplied through Indirect potable reuse and how IPR losses should be considered.
- 2 The issue paper should address how agencies may comply regionally, including how the regional target may be calculated, what type of agreements are required and what factors will be considered when approving a region
3. Method 2 will need to address how agencies will distinguish which landscapes are subject to the 1992 landscape ordinance design criteria or the special design criteria under the current landscape ordinance
4. How will agencies do weather normalization when there is no weather station available? How will agencies account for multiple ET zones?

In the charter we have the following comment

The charter should state that DWR will give primary consideration to consensus recommendations of the USC and that DWR will try to reach consensus on critical or significant issues
