The Tulare Irrigation District would like to request a 30-day extension (until the end of April) on the request for levels of support or disagreement for the proposed regulations. This extension will allow irrigation districts such as ours the ability to review the proposed regulations and potential impacts with our board of directors. Without such review, with our board of directors, the Tulare Irrigation District must take a **Fundamental Disagreement** stance. It must also be noted that with only a three-day window for review and comment, the Department of Water Resources will be pursuing this regulation based upon district staff direction and not truly representing the individual district stance based upon board direction. Being that this regulation has a significant financial impact upon districts it should be an integral part of the process to seek board of director direction in this matter.
