

**CalConserve Water Use Efficiency Revolving Fund  
Proposition 1 Proposal Solicitation Package**



**Notice of Public Comment Period on  
Draft Funding Recommendation  
November 2, 2016**

By the application deadline of August 31, 2016, the Department of Water Resources (DWR) received two proposals in response to the CalConserve Water Use Efficiency Revolving Fund Proposition 1 Proposal Solicitation Package (PSP). \$3.25 million in funding was requested for proposed projects totaling \$6.24 million. DWR had approximately \$10 million available for loans in this solicitation.

Both eligible applications were scored and ranked in accordance to the scoring criteria published in the PSP. As stated in the PSP, only proposals with a passing score of 70 or more will be invited to complete loan documentation in Phase 2. Both proposals are recommended to be invited to Phase 2, loan processing.

The total requested in loan funds from the two proposals amounted to \$3.25 million, leaving \$6.5 in loan funds available. As mentioned in the PSP, the remaining funds will be made available on a first-come, first-served basis using the published guidelines in PSP once the current awards are made final.

The proportion of loan funds expected to directly benefit Disadvantaged Communities or Economically Distressed Areas is estimated to be at least 10 percent of the total loan amount awarded.

Prospective borrowers should be aware that receiving loan funds and execution of a loan agreement will be contingent upon compliance with applicable laws and regulations (as listed in Attachment 7 of the PSP) and completion during Phase 2 of all required documents listed in Part B of the PSP.

Loan agreement execution is contingent upon borrower's compliance with all of the requirements as applicable no later than a year from the date of announcing the final loan awards. Failure to comply may result in the withdrawal of the loan award.
