Saudi Prince Sultan Bin Abdulaziz is offering a prize of \$266,000 for creativity in water resource research. The Creativity Prize will be awarded to any original work (research, invention, technique, etc.) that is considered a breakthrough in any water-related field. The work must be practically applicable, economically feasible, and environmentally friendly.
