Last two Water Plan regional workshops set

The final two of the 12 regional workshops about the Public Review Draft of the **California Water Plan Update 2009** will be held tomorrow and on May 28. The workshops will be held:

- Tomorrow, Thursday, May 21, in Antioch for the Delta Region
- Friday, May 28, in Yreka for the North Coast Region
